Seven Biblical Facts about Christ's Coming

1. Christ is _____ Coming.

- *Acts 1:11* - "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."

2. _____ will _____ Christ's Coming.

- *Revelation 1:7* - Look, he is coming with the clouds, and every eye will see him, even those who pierced him; and all the peoples of the earth will mourn because of him. So shall it be! Amen.

3. Christ will come in _____.

- *Psalms 50:3* - Our God comes and will not be silent; a fire devours before him, and around him a tempest rages.

4. Christ's Coming is _____.

- *Revelation 14:14* - I looked, and there before me was a white cloud, and seated on the cloud was one "like a son of man" with a crown of gold on his head and a sharp sickle in his hand.

5. _____ will _____ Christ's Coming.

- *Jeremiah 25:30* - The LORD will roar from on high; he will thunder from his holy dwelling and roar mightily against his land.

6. A _____ will _____.

- *1 Thessalonians 4:16-17* - For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first. After that, we who are still alive and are left will be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And so we will be with the Lord forever.

7. _____ one _____ when.

- *Matthew 24:36-40*
- *2 Peter 3:10* - But the day of the Lord will come like a thief. The heavens will disappear with a roar; the elements will be destroyed by fire, and the earth and everything in it will be laid bare.
- *Genesis 7:23* - Only Noah was left, and those with him in the ark.
- "The Blessed Hope of the early church was not a pretribulation rapture but the second coming of Christ at the end of the Tribulation. Pretribulationism is a teaching which arose in the nineteenth century among the Plymouth Brethren whence it came to America where it was warmly received and widely propagated. However, many devout men who first accepted this teaching were later, upon mature study, compelled to reverse themselves and admit that they could not find this doctrine in the Word of God."
